

Wind Energy

The Public Utility Commission of Texas' Competitive Renewable Energy Zones (CREZ) Project resulted in the construction of the CREZ transmission lines (CREZ line) that carry electricity from the Texas Panhandle to the more densely populated areas in Texas (e.g., Austin, Dallas, Fort Worth, San Antonio) have resulted in a boom in wind development in the Texas Panhandle and South Plains. In addition to the CREZ lines, the Southwest Power Pool continues its efforts to expand transmission facilities to further develop the excellent renewable resources in the region.
